# **Trial Packs**

The aim of the trial pack is to provide parents with samples of good quality, reliable nappies, a wrap and accessories to help parents make an informed decision when choosing reusable nappies. There are three types of nappies in the pack: a Lollipop bamboo nappy, a Littlelamb microfibre nappy and a Tots Bots Easyfit (Teenyfit in newborn sized packs). Each pack also includes a Littlelamb wrap. The cost of the kit for City of Edinburgh residents is £12 and £42 for East Lothian, West Lothian and Midlothian residents (please see below for an explanation about the differences in cost\*). You will get approx. £46-£48 worth of nappies/accessories.

Three sizes are available: Newborn (birth up to 10lbs), Small/Medium (10 - 20lbs) and Large (20 - 35lbs).

After applying for a pack it will be available for collection from Changeworks, at a Nappuccino or it can be posted out to you using the Royal Mail 'recorded signed for' service at a cost of £3.49.

Please note that trial packs are limited to one application per household and are for parents who are not already using real nappies on their baby.

# Nappy Lending Kits

Lending kits are available to borrow for three weeks. There are eight kinds of nappies in the kits: Tots Bots Cotton, Tots Bots Bamboozle, Bambinex Teddy, Motherease one size, Bumgenius (Nature Babies Stuffable Lite in extra small kits), Tots Bots Easyfit (Teenyfit in small kits), Cotton Square and Bamboo Square. There are also Motherease Sandy nappies in the small and medium sized kits. We will supply nappy buckets, laundry meshes, paper and fleece liners, and waterproof wraps - everything you need!

The lending kits should be returned after the agreed lending period and will be laundered by a professional laundering company before being passed onto the next parent. Lending kits cost £12 for City of Edinburgh residents and £55 for East Lothian, West Lothian and Midlothian residents (please see below for an explanation about the differences in cost\*). A deposit of £50 is required. Deposits would ideally be in the form of a cheque that will not be cashed unless kits are returned damaged or incomplete.

Four sizes are available.

After applying for a lending kit, it will be available for collection from Changeworks or at a Nappuccino by prior arrangement.

\*The Changeworks Real Nappy Project currently receives funding from The City of Edinburgh Council. This funding subsidises the trial packs and lending kits for Edinburgh residents.

The project does not receive funding from other councils. As a result, the costs of the trial pack and lending kits to Midlothian, West Lothian and East Lothian Council residents has had to increase in order to reflect the true cost of these in terms nappy costs, staff time and laundering etc.

Therefore trial packs are now £42 (excluding postage) and lending kits are now £55. The trial packs are still a bit cheaper than if you were to buy all the nappies and accessories yourself (a new born trial pack would cost you about £46 or one of the other sizes would be about £48). By ordering the pack you will be getting the convenience of three nappies, accessories and a 'wet bag' altogether, which will also save you time, rather than having to search for and order the individual nappies and accessories yourself.
